
::: ? How do I find and RSVP to a flyering event/action?

FIND scheduled campaign actions and events on the local Sutherland Shire calendar

Actions and events like flyering are regularly being added to this calendar so keep checking back. Simply find an event/action that suits and click RSVP to join an event or action that suits you!

(FYI, this sits on the national Yes23 website - just so you don't feel disoriented!)

TIP - when viewing the calendar - you can adjust your view by clicking either "month", "week" or "list" in the top left corner. (see image below).



::: ? Who can help me out if I have questions?

Eric H will be organising logistics for flyering events (checking in on RSVPs, getting collateral (flyers) to locations and being there to help answer your questions.

Flyering is lots of fun! Depending on the location it can be fast paced and involve smiling, saying hello and basically just trying to get someone to take a flyer (train stations tend to be like that) OR it can be a little more relaxed and involve a question or two and a longer chat.

Regardless, you will be with other volunteers who have flyered before and can help orient you. Never ever be afraid to say you're not sure of an answer - no-one expects you to know everything! You can always refer them to another volunteer or an information site like ves23.com.au.

Our campaign is inclusive and unifying. We want anyone who wants to support a Voice to Parliament feel welcome - no matter what their politics. Same goes for our interactions with the public. When we are out and about campaigning, people are observing us - let's leave a universally positive impression and give them every reason to vote YES!

(Basically, don't play into the hands of the NO campaign - this is above politics and by leaving it out, we leave the option open for people to act on good information and their own conscience.)
